CITY COUNCIL

On July 25, 2002, the City Council voted to approve the zone change on the Green Heights subdivision from an R-1 zone to an R-2 zone. This will allow the owners to put in more lots because the minimum lot size is 5,000 sf in an R-2 zone rather than 7,500 in an R-1 zone. The subdivision is located next to Wascher School, and ground is expected to be broken yet this summer. The City Council voted to accept the bid for the construction of the new Wilson Street Pump Station from Stanley Contracting for a total project cost of \$397,245. Construction is expected to begin August 12, 2002.
