WATER PROJECT UPDATE

The joint water project with Dayton has progressed well, and is expected to be complete and fully operational by this summer. The installation of the transmission lines has been completed, the wells have been drilled, and the reservoir has been constructed. The reservoir is located on Ferry St. in Dayton. The computers and other technical equipment needed to operate the system are now being installed, and the additional water sources and storage facilities will be a welcome addition for both cities.

CITY COUNCIL UPDATE

The City Council recently amended the utility billing policies (see the back of your utility bill for explanation), and will be adopting the Parks Master Plan at their February 5, 2004 meeting. The Parks Master Plan is a necessary component in obtaining funding for future parks projects.

There is now a vacancy on the City Council. You must reside within the City limits for one year and be a registered voter in Yamhill County in order to qualify. The Planning Commission and Budget Committee also have openings. Please pick up an application at City Hall if you are interested.
