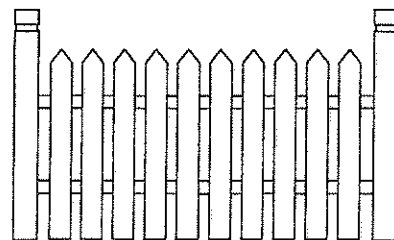

ARE YOU BUILDING A FENCE?????

Lafayette's Municipal Code states that prior to constructing ANY fence, a permit must be obtained from the City. An accurate scale drawing which indicates the height and location of the fence (with reference to any public way, property line, or structure) is required before the permit will be issued. There are regulations which dictate where fences are allowed in regard to property lines, corner lots, and vision clearances and the fence permit process helps the City to ensure your fence is in compliance with those regulations.
