CITY COUNCIL

At the April 25, 2002 City Council meeting, the City Council received the pre-design report from Montgomery Watson for the new wastewater treatment plant. The Council is currently reviewing this report. The Council requested a walkthrough of the Industrial site, which is the proposed site for the wastewater treatment plant. There will be a special meeting held on Thursday, May 2, 2002 at 6:30 p.m. The Council will meet at City Hall and then Brett Teel, the principal engineer of this project from Montgomery Watson, will be giving a tour of the Industrial site. After the tour, the meeting will reconvene at City Hall to address further comments on the pre-design report. The public is invited to attend this meeting.

The City Council also terminated the City Administrator, Phil Lieberman, without cause, on April 25, 2002. He was terminated by a 4-2 vote of the Council. He will remain on call for the staff for 30 days. A special meeting of the Council was held on Monday, April 29, 2002 where the Council appointed Richard Van Orman as Interim City Administrator. Richard works for the Council of Governments and will be contracted through them for a period of 90 days while the City searches for a new City Administrator. The City is also searching for a new City Attorney, as Beery & Elsner resigned on March 18, 2002.

A copy of the budget is also available at City Hall.
