## CITY COUNCIL

At the September 12, 2002 City Council meeting, the Council voted unanimously to authorize the Interim City Administrator sign the MAO (Mutual Agreement Order) with DEQ (Department of Environmental Quality). The Mutual Agreement Order establishes discharge limits for the current plant until the new plant is built. The MAO also sets a timeline for the completion of the sewer plant project, which the City is expected to follow.

The Council also adopted a set of park rules that promotes the enjoyment, safety, and convenience of all users of the City's park and recreational facilities. The rules will be posted in each of the City's parks and copies are available at City Hall.

The City Council is going to discuss the scheduling of a candidate's forum at the September 26, 2002 Council meeting. Please watch the City's reader board for updates on this. Come meet the people who are running for your City Council!
