Rhodes was elected on a campaign to bring progress to our city, yet immediately aligned himself with the old leadership. If he is not removed from the council, Lafayette will continue to experience non-productive and burdensome approaches to city matters. His actions demonstrate that he has a total lack of regard for citizen input and he discourages citizen involvement; he operates in deceptive and biased ways and abuses council rules for his personal benefit. Rhodes is the single biggest threat to our city liberties since he is skilled in manipulating fact to support his agenda. Rhodes has been the most outspoken advocate for year round water rationing and for a new multi-million dollar reservoir although he has produced no evidence to support it. Rhodes authored the recent charter resolution that was deceptively written to remove the government spending limit of which he and three other councilmen voted in favor of. Rhodes was an ardent supporter of the former city administrator that caused much contention and that Rhodes himself stated "we all know she is a poor performer" yet he gave her high marks. Conversely, Rhodes harasses the new administrator who is in total support of citizen involvement and creative solutions.

1. Supplying false information on this form may result in conviction of a felony with a fine of up to \$125,000 and/or prison for up to 5 years. (ORS 260.715)
2. Violations of the circulator requirements may result in conviction of a felony with a fine of up to \$125,000 and/or prison for up to 5 years.

### Instructions for Circulators

- Only active registered voters of the public official's electoral district may sign a petition.
- All signers on any one signature sheet must be active registered voters of the same county.
- It is advisable to have signers use a pen for signing petitions or for certifying petitions.
- Only one circulator may collect signatures on any one sheet of a petition.
- Each circulator must personally witness all signatures the circulator collects.
- Circulators must not write, alter, correct, clarify or obscure on a signature sheet any information about the signer unless the signer initials changes made or the signer is disabled and requests assistance in completing optional information.
- Circulators must not cause to be circulated a petition knowing it to contain a false signature.
- Circulators must not knowingly make any false statement to any person who signs it or requests information about it.
- Circulators must not attempt to obtain the signature of a person knowing that the person is not qualified to sign it.
- Circulators must not offer money or any thing of value to another person to sign or not sign a petition.
- Circulators must not sell or offer to sell signature sheets.

### Instructions for Signers

- Only active registered voters of the public official's electoral district may sign a petition. Sign your full name, as you did when you registered to vote.
- Fill in the date you signed the petition, your printed name and your residence or mailing address in the space provided.
- It is advisable to use a pen for signing petitions.
- Initial changes you or the circulator make to your printed name, residence or mailing address or date you signed the petition.
- It is unlawful to sign a petition more than once.
- It is unlawful to sign any person's name other than your own. Do not sign another person's name under any circumstances.
- It is unlawful for a person to knowingly sign a petition when the person is not qualified to sign it.
