July 21, 2009 - I have informed the Council and City Administrator that I am not willing to sign the current Charter resolution that was initiated by Administrator Rinks and voted for by Councilor's Dean Rhodes, Nick Harris, Bob Cullen and Michael Roberts. The intent of this resolution is to eliminate the \$1 million dollar spending limit in our City Charter. This resolution moves the issue forward to go to ballot before the people in November. My statement to Council reads:

I've decided that I won't be signing the resolution for the Charter spending limit change. I believe the process in which this resolution came about, and also the language that is being given to the people of Lafayette is based in deception and I personally, and morally can't put my name to this.
