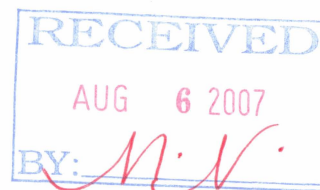

Re: Complaint, City of Lafayette  
Destruction of Public Records

This letter is a request to investigate violations regarding the tampering / destruction of public records by the City of Lafayette. Below is a timeline of actions and responses. I have attached all documentation as referenced.

It is my hope that all involved parties will be investigated and prosecuted, as appropriate.

Timeline:

June 22, 2007	City Council meeting with Executive Session to evaluate the City Administrator.
June 28, 2007	Received email from an anonymous "John Smith" telling me to request emails from City Hall to get information on the evaluation.
July 1, 2007	Made the request to city hall to receive emails from city hall for last 60 days.
July 6, 2007	Revised request to receive emails from city hall to last 30 days between city hall and council.
July 13, 2007	Received some emails
July 13, 2007	Advised city staff some information missing.
July 16, 2007	Received email advising information missing will not be provided as she felt it was to be excluded.

July 24, 2007	Submitted request to receive all contents of evaluation of city administrator.
July 31, 2007	Received some evaluation forms from city staff.
August 1, 2007	Advised city staff that at least 2 evaluation forms were missing.
<b>August 3, 2007</b>	<b>City staff advised missing items have been destroyed.</b>

I will be requesting additional years' evaluations, so I will advise if any further information has been destroyed.
