Water Update

Dear Water Customer:

Our goal is to provide every citizen of this community with an adequate water supply. Unfortunately, with the hot weather, this has not proven to be adequate to keep up with the demand that has occurred over the last few weeks, and the reservoir has fallen to a level that requires action by the City.

At this time we have no other choice but to declare that water usage must be curtailed. The restrictions that are going into effect JULY 27, 2010 are listed below.

I am asking you to make every effort to comply with these restrictions and conserve water in any other way you can.

NOTICE

PLEASE BE ADVISED THAT The City Administrator of Lafayette has declared a Level 1 Water Crisis Beginning July 27, 2010

THE FOLLOWING ACTIVITIES FOR WATERING ARE REQUIRED UNDER A LEVEL 1 DECLARATION:

ODD/EVEN WATERING

-EVEN NUMBERED ADDRESSES CAN ONLY WATER ON EVEN NUMBERED DAYS OF THE MONTH.

-ODD NUMBERED ADDRESSES CAN ONLY WATER ON ODD NUMBERED DAYS OF THE MONTH.

THIS DECLARATION WILL REMAIN IN EFFECT UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE.
