

## **Lafayette Water Task Force Areas for Study**

- 1) **Lafayette Production and Storage Assets** – Water Rights and Agreements, Well and Spring Production Capabilities and Reservoir Storage Capacities and limits. City Engineer’s responsibility, recommendation and past reports. Review of past water production sources and efficiencies. Identify areas for improving utilization or rehabilitating assets.
  
- 2) **Lafayette Water Requirements** - Agreements to deliver water, City Fire Protection requirements, Residential historic consumption and projections.
  
- 3) **Process and Procedures** – Governing documents review and recommendations. Determine the indicators that would justify placing the city into water restrictions, determine expected outcomes. Research and determine alternative means to enhance residential water conservation.
  
- 4) **Dayton partnership** - Agreements, Rights, Expectations, Responsibilities. Review and recommend prior to first official meeting between cities.
  
- 5) **Reports to Council and citizens** – Develop the report process. Reports that should be provided to Council at each meeting in order to oversee operations. Additional reports that should be provided as the city approaches the conditions that require enforcing water restrictions. Daily reports required while in water restrictions in order to monitor and manage.
  
- 6) **Budget Review and Rate Reductions feasibility.**
  
- 7) **Short and Long Term Infrastructure Investment recommendations.**
