A RESOLUTION AMENDING
WATER RATES FOR THE CITY OF
LAFAYETTE, OREGON.

RESOLUTION No. 00-29

THE CITY COUNCIL (the "Council") OF THE CITY OF LAFAYETTE, OREGON (the "City")
sat for the transaction of City business on Thursday, October 26, 2000 at 7:00 p.m. in the Council
Chambers of Lafayette City Hall

WHEREAS, the Lafayette City Council has, pursuant to Lafayette City Code (LCC) Section 4.155,
the ability to set rates for users of its water and sanitary sewer utilities;

WHEREAS, the Council has heretofore provided for water user rates by Resolution 98-24A adopted
by the Council on December 11, 1997;

WHEREAS, the Council finds that it is necessary to amend the water user rates to reflect ongoing
increases in the cost of operating the water system and, by this Resolution, shall hereby amend
Resolution 98-24A.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED as follows:


- Section 1. Effective January 20, 2001 the monthly minimum charge for the first 300 cubic feet,
or any part thereof, in any month shall increase \$2.00 per unit for all classes of users.
- Section 2. Effective each January 20 thereafter the monthly minimum charge for the first 300
cubic feet, or any part thereof, in any month shall increase \$2.00 per unit for all
classes of users.
- Section 3. Except as amended in Sections 1 and 2 above, rates established or authorized in
Resolution 98-24A shall remain in full force and effect until further amended,
changed, or adjusted by future councils, and are not binding on those bodies.
